CAP to Host Grand Opening For Eugene Field Early Childhood Education Center

Community Action Project of Tulsa County will host a grand opening celebration for its new Eugene Field Early Childhood Education Center, located at 1116 W. 22nd St, at 1:30 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 30.

Speakers will include Senator Tom Adelson, Tulsa Public Schools Superintendent Dr. Keith Ballard, Ken Levit from the George Kaiser Family Foundation and CAP Executive Director Steven Dow, among others. Remarks begin at 1:30 p.m.; tours of the building are available from 2:00-3:00 p.m.

The Center will provide 12 classrooms to serve approximately 120 children ages birth through three.

The Eugene Field Early Childhood Education Center is operated by Community Action Project in partnership with Family & Children's Services. It is supported by funding from the State of Oklahoma and private donors, including the George Kaiser Family Foundation, as part of the State of Oklahoma's Pilot Early Childhood Program, which seeks to enhance and expand high quality early childhood education throughout Oklahoma for children birth through three years of age.
